Evelyn Frensey Scholarship for Outstanding Achievement in Science or Mathematics

The Scholarship for Outstanding Achievement in Science or Mathematics is presented annually to two high school juniors in Harris County who demonstrate exceptional achievement and ability in science or mathematics. Each high school within Harris County is requested to nominate one high school junior for this award. Each student selected as an Outstanding Science Scholar will receive a \$1,500 scholarship awarded at a luncheon in the fall of 2010.

Instructions/Rules:

1. Each high school, public or private, within Harris County may nominate one junior student.
2. Descriptions should be typed and double-spaced.
3. All materials must be submitted together in a self-contained binder or folder **postmarked no later than April 19, 2010.**
4. Finalists will be selected by a Museum review committee. Awards will be presented at a luncheon in the fall of 2010.

Nominations should include:

- This nomination form.
- One letter of recommendation each from the school principal or assistant principal, and a teacher.
- The following information from the student nominee:
 1. Curriculum Vitae or Resume.
 2. High School transcript.
 3. SAT, ACT or other standardized test scores.
 4. A 300-word or less essay about plans for college and future career.
 5. A 500-word or less description of a project or activity that best demonstrates ability and interest in science or mathematics.
