The Education Programs Facilitator will be trained to deliver all programs and topics in each of the Museum's many outreach programs (Bugs on Wheels, Wildlife on Wheels, Science on Stage, Discovery Dome, Science Starts and Earth Science on Wheels); and will provide a high-quality educational experience for students and other audience members as well as outstanding customer service.
