As such, we are looking for fun individuals to help facilitate our birthday parties and interpret museum displays for our guests.

As part of the job duties, Birthday Party Assistants will be trained in interpretation for tours of the various exhibit halls. This position is available for our two locations: Hermann Park and/or Sugar Land. This position reports to the Birthday Party Programs Manager.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Deliver exceptional experiences to patrons
- Set up, decorate and clean the party spaces
- Manage party timeline to adhere to tight deadlines
- Make changes based on feedback from party parents and Education supervisors
- Supervise and interact with children of all ages in a fun, positive way
- Lead tours through various exhibit halls
- Lead assigned crafts for party guests
- Assist setting up and serving parent-provided foods, including cutting the cake, plating, distributing and clean-up
- Help party parents transport items to and from their cars
- Other duties as assigned
- Comply with the museum's health and safety protocols
